Anthony Muñoz to keynote the Cincinnati-Hamilton County Community Action Agency's 45th Annual Luncheon

(Cincinnati, OH) – The Cincinnati-Hamilton County Community Action Agency (CAA) will celebrate 45 years of service at its Annual Luncheon on Monday, October 26, 2009 from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at the Westin Hotel downtown. CAA is a private, nonprofit organization that has served as a lifeline for low-income children and adults throughout Hamilton County for more than four decades. CAA provides assistance with employment, supportive services, home energy, early childhood education, housing, and youth programs.

Anthony Muñoz, a former Cincinnati Bengal and one of the area's most recognized community activists, will serve as the keynote speaker for this year's luncheon. Mr. Muñoz knows the importance of investing in the community. He founded the Anthony Muñoz Foundation, a nonprofit organization that engages Tri-State area youth, and currently serves as the PNC Bank Community Ambassador. Mr. Muñoz is also the only Bengals player to be admitted into the Pro Football Hall of Fame.

For CAA, the Annual Luncheon is a time to look back over its past year of service to celebrate successes, better understand challenges that lie ahead, and reaffirm its commitment to serving low-income families in our community. This year's theme "Community Action Speaks Louder than Words" serves to commend the efforts that CAA's staff, advocates, and allies have put into alleviating the hardships the community has faced during these tough economic times.
