Actor Malik Yoba to keynote the Cincinnati-Hamilton County Community Action Agency's 46th Annual Luncheon

(Cincinnati, OH) – The Cincinnati-Hamilton County Community Action Agency (CAA) will celebrate 46 years of service at its Annual Luncheon on Friday, October 29, 2010, from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at The Westin Cincinnati. CAA is a private, nonprofit organization that has served as a lifeline for low-income children and adults throughout Hamilton County for more than four decades. CAA provides assistance with employment, supportive services, home utility bill assistance, home weatherization, early childhood education, housing, and youth programs.

For CAA, the Annual Luncheon is a time to look back over its past year of service to celebrate successes, better understand challenges that lie ahead, and reaffirm its commitment to serving low-income families in our community. This year's theme "Compassion. Commitment. Change." speaks to the efforts of CAA's staff, advocates, and allies in alleviating the hardships the community has faced during these tough economic times.

This year's keynote speaker is actor and youth advocate Malik Yoba, well-known for his roles in Tyler Perry's "Why Did I Get Married?" and "New York Undercover." Prior to his acting career, Mr. Yoba worked with AIDP (Attendance Improvement Dropout Prevention), an organization for inner-city New York Public Schools students. He also served as Vice President of the City Kids Foundation, a New York City based youth leadership organization, and founded the City Kids Foundation's Los Angeles branch.
