Through education and supportive services, CAA's **Construction Training Programs** assist young adults in obtaining a new, promising livelihood.



Education

CAA's Construction Training Programs provide classroom instruction and hands-on training in the construction field. Students work side-by-side with industry professionals to earn a national certification in construction.

Upon graduation, students interested in continuing their construction career are guaranteed an interview in the field. Others wishing to further their education are given the resources and assistance to help reach their goals.



Supportive Services

Each Construction Training Program offers life skills training, mentoring, and supportive services. Students have access to the many services offered by CAA, including: GED classes, financial assistance, utility bill payment assistance, counseling, and child care.

Eligibility

Our Construction Training Programs require that students:

- Be a resident of Hamilton County
- Be at least 16 years old
- Have dropped out of high school, be unemployed, underemployed, or an ex-offender

All participants must have a library card and a State Identification card.

Blueprint for Success

Blueprint for Success provides construction training and supportive services for City of Cincinnati residents between the ages of 18-30.

YouthBuild Construction & Training Program
