Life doesn't wait. Let CAA provide the support you need.

CAA's **Supportive Services** program helps families during emergency situations in obtaining some of life's immediate necessities. Individuals and families can turn to CAA for:

- Bus tokens when visiting CAA offices for services
- Case management services
- Vouchers for lifeline telephone assistance
- Food vouchers
- Rental and mortgage payment assistance
- Water bill payment assistance

We also provide assistance in obtaining:

- Birth certificates
- Police checks
- Prescribed medications
- Referrals for other social services, such as assistance with prescription eye glasses and eye exams
- State Identification cards



Eligibility

Eligible individuals must:

- Be a resident of Hamilton County
- Earn an income at or below 125% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines.

Please note: Other specific eligibility requirements may apply for some services.
